EPD Definitions

Expected progeny differences (EPDs) can be used to predict the average performance of a bull's offspring compared to other calves in their contemporary group (a contemporary group being calves that were born in the same calving season, in the same year, herd, sex, and were managed similarly). Listed below are the definitions of American Gelbvieh Association EPDs and the units in which they are published.

Maternal traits

Calving ease direct (CED): Percent of unassisted births of a bull's calves when he is used on heifers. A higher number is favorable, meaning better calving ease. This EPD can be vital to a rancher looking to decrease the amount of calves pulled in his herd.

Milk (Milk): The genetic ability of a sire's daughters to produce milk expressed in pounds of weaning weight.

Calving ease maternal (CEM): Represented as percent of unassisted births in a sire's first-calving daughters. A higher number represents more favorable calving ease. This EPD is important to a rancher's bottom line because it predicts which animals produce daughters with a genetic predisposition to calve unassisted as heifers.

Growth traits

Birth weight (BW): Predicts the difference, in pounds, for birth weight of the calf.

Weaning weight (WW): Predicts the difference, in pounds, for weaning weight (adjusted to age of dam and a standard 205 days of age). This is an indicator of growth from birth to weaning.

Yearling weight (YW): Predicts the expected difference, in pounds, for yearling weight (adjusted to a standard 365 days of age). This is an indicator of growth from birth to yearling.

Carcass traits

Carcass weight (CW): Differences in pounds of hot carcass weight, adjusted to an industry standard age endpoint.

His dam, D6133, has been a mainstay in our herd and already has a daughter that's a Dam of Merit. He'll add hip height and frame, bringing extra size and pounds you can hang your hat on. A great fit for a Red Angus-based cow herd looking to add growth and stretch!

Terms of Sale

This sale is conducted under the standard terms and conditions as adopted by the American Gelbvieh Association. Each animal becomes the buyers's risk as soon as sold.

Breeding Guarantee: All bulls will have passed a breeding soundness examination prior to the sale and are guaranteed breeders. The only exception is illness, injury, or death after the sale. We guarantee our bulls for 1 breeding season (90 days after turnout). If any question arises after a breeding season, Turkey Creek Gelbvieh requires a certified examination by a veterinarian and returned to the seller. We will refund the value of the purchase price, minus salvage value, once bill of sale is received. All disputes must be settled by Nov. 1, 2026

Viewing: Bulls will be penned at Stockmen's the afternoon before and morning of the sale. Additional pictures and videos are available on our website and by request.

Herd Health: All bulls have been fully vaccinated, poured, and EID tagged for out of state travel. The Turkey Creek Gelbvieh herd is maintained a strict vaccination schedule.

Delivery: We will deliver bulls for free within 100 miles of Volin, SD. Over 100 miles arrangements will be made with the buyer to meet and share costs. Bulls will be boarded until April 15, 2026 free of charge. After that date, buyers will be charged \$3.50/day yardage. Bulls taken home day of the sale will receive a \$100 discount.

We continue to develop bulls based off a maternally strong cow herd and utilize breed leading sires to provide performance and growth. Coming from a commercial cow/calf and feeder/finisher background, we understand all segments of the American beef production chain and the requirements of each. The genetic pressure we have placed on our cows has led to a 97% pregnancy rate the past two years, with many of our females sticking to AI and maintaining a 365 calving interval!

All bulls have been developed on a TMR diet to express muscle and growth, but to also prevent any possible feet and leg issues. Calves received a high fiber, no grain creep feed prior to weaning to help with the transition off their mothers and into the development yard. BSE results and scrotal measurements will be completed prior to the sale and available on the sale day supplement sheet. Results will be uploaded to our website and Facebook page and soon as they are available.
